

## What To Bring:

Below are items suggested to bring for the SASI Drum Major Camp:

### General:

- Linens (sheets, pillows, etc..) as they will not be provided by the university.
- Towels
- Toiletries and other personal items
- Athletic-like clothing
  - We will be doing the marching session outside. Marching will include jogging, stretching, and marching. Clothing that is loose-fitting, light-colored, and comfortable is recommended.
- Tennis shoes
  - We will be spending quite a bit of time on our feet during the 3-day camp. Tennis shoes are necessary for the marching portion of the camp and are recommended for the walking we will be doing between locations.
- Sun glasses and/or a hat.
- Sun screen.
- Re-fillable water bottle
  - We will be spending time outside, and a water bottle (preferably insulated) is necessary for these sessions. “Band practice” water bottles are the best option.
- Light jacket or hoodie
  - It is often chilly in the larger rooms we use for leadership and conducting. Many students opt to bring a light jacket.

### Social Events:

There are two social events during the camp; a luau, and a party/dance in the evening.

#### Luau:

- Appropriate bathing suit
- Flip flops
- Beach towel

#### Party/Dance:

- This is a casual event. Dresses or suits, while acceptable, are not necessary. Many students choose to wear jeans and a shirt or top other than a t-shirt.
- We will give students plenty of time to “clean up”, and group portraits will be offered.
